



Overview of Extended Day Offerings

We are pleased to welcome you to PLĀ, Baker's extended day program. This dynamic program reflects our commitment to provide a fun and secure after-school environment for your children. Baker's PLĀ (Progressive Learning Activities) program exemplifies progressive, best-practice methods and enrichment through an active, play-based approach, offering two separate sections for students in Early Childhood (PK-K) and Grades 1-8. PLĀ fosters respectful social relationships, provides a fun and relaxing family-like atmosphere, and values health and safety. Flexible participation is supported through a wide variety of indoor and outdoor sports and recreational activities, arts and crafts, as well as a dedicated homework club, cooking classes, and Friday open swim (life-guarded) for students in Grades 1-8. Our quality program offers opportunities to play, study, and socialize for students of working families and for those who are simply looking to extend their day at Baker. Healthy, peanut- and nut-free snacks are offered immediately after school.

Every year there is great demand for PLĀ. As our primary goal is to provide safe, consistent, and respectful supervision, we must limit the number of students accepted into the program. To meet the needs of our busy families whose schedules change from semester to semester, contract fees (below) are semester-based, and PLĀ enrollment and payment will be processed separately prior to the start of each semester. Semester rates are based on even distribution of school days; Semester One registration allows students to attend PLĀ from the first day of school through mid-January, with Semester Two ending on the day prior to the last day of school when students are dismissed at 11:30. Semester Two registration will be open in December, 2017. Of course, you may join PLĀ at any time throughout the school year (given space availability) as fees are prorated on a monthly basis.

Daily drop-in services are available as space permits and are meant to be used in cases of emergency or for occasional use. For PLĀ drop-in participation, email Nancy Perla (nperla@bakerdemschool.org) at least one day in advance to reserve a space. We understand that this is not always possible and will always do our best to meet your needs. The hourly rate for drop-in participation is \$16 per hour, and you will be invoiced through the business office.

Several full-day PLĀ days are scheduled for 2017-18. These days include teacher institute, records, and conference days (school holidays and breaks not included). Full-day PLĀ activities include free swim (grades 1-8), a field trip or special activity at school, as well as hot lunch and an afternoon G-rated movie. Space is limited on these days, and students with PLĀ contracts have priority registration as well as a reduction in the activity fee for the day. Registration opportunities for Semester One full-day PLĀ dates will be available in early September.
