Since its founding in 1918, Baker families have played an incredibly important role in the life of the School. Baker encourages parents to be an active part of daily school life and provide financial support beyond tuition.

Baker Parent Organization (BPO)

The BPO is a group of parents who volunteer their time to coordinate events and activities that bring parents and families together for community building, learning, and supporting goals of the school. At Baker, there are no membership fees to participate, so all parents are part of the BPO.

The BPO is organized into three main areas:

Community Connections

Organizes social events for our parents and families to connect outside of school

Service

Works to enrich the community by providing service opportunities aligned with the goals of each school year

Communication

Provides communication to parents about BPO-organized events and socials through room parents and the school bulletin. Organizes school outreach events in surrounding communities


